## FOREWORD

By the Professor of History in  
The University of Western Australia.

The presentation of this Guide for students working or desirous of working in the field of Western Australian history is an indirect result of the Commonwealth Government's post-war grants for research and for the training of research workers in the social sciences. Before the war, young graduates of the Department of History in this University who wished to proceed with research work for higher degrees were thrown more or less on their own resources. Intermittent assistance and general supervision were given by members of a small lecturing staff whose preoccupation with undergraduate teaching and other duties rarely left them time to acquire special knowledge of the field in which the research was planned. Generous help, official and unofficial, from custodians of documents and from previous reapers in neighbouring fields was appreciated. Some of the results may be seen in the unpublished Honours and Master of Arts theses listed on pp. 65-9 below. These results, however, were often limited by the student's lack of knowledge of the existence of other available material, while the assistance of enthusiasts, themselves without special training in the technique of historical research, occasionally introduced some strange tares into the harvested crop.

A very important preliminary to more effective research was the appointment by the Government of Western Australia, in 1945, of an archivist attached to the staff of the State Public Library and Art Gallery. At the end of 1947, the University secured Commonwealth concurrence in the appointment for twelve months of Mr. Paul Hasluck, M.A., as full-time Research Reader in History, part of his duties being to organise and supervise the research work of graduates in the history of Western Australia. Mr. Hasluck's appointment was the more appropriate since he had made his acquaintance with the available source material and learnt his research

techniques the hard way, a decade or so earlier, in preparing the manuscript of Black Australians (Melbourne, 1942), originally a thesis for the degree of Master of Arts. In 1949, when Mr. Hasluck became fully occupied with his work on the official History of Australia in the War of 1939-45, his duties in the supervision of research in the Department of History in the University were taken over by Mr. Frank Crowley, M.A., as Research Fellow in History, again with financial provision from Commonwealth research funds. The fact that Mr. Crowley had previously been engaged for some years in historical research at the University of Melbourne provides an opportunity to express appreciation of continuous co-operation over many years of the Melbourne School of History, under Professor R. M. Crawford. The further fact that Mr. Crowley will shortly leave for Oxford as a research scholar of the Australian National University prompts the hope of future contributions to the extent and quality of research in the social sciences in outlying Australian universities when the Research School of Social Science is eventually established at Canberra.

It had originally been intended to seek funds for the publication of this Guide in printed form but Mr. Crowley was reluctant to suggest permanent value for a Guide which still lacked a substantially complete record of unclassified sources at present housed in certain Government departments and elsewhere. It is hoped to remedy this defect by a supplementary issue in two or three years' time when the requisite information is available and the material concerned is housed more accessibly, preferably under an archivist's control. Meanwhile, the potential user of this Guide should not be misled by Mr. Crowley's modesty into ignoring the fact that it already includes a substantial amount of classified material in and from Government departments.

## PREFACE

This guide has been compiled to provide research workers with a list of the principal accessible sources for the study of the history of Western Australia. It is not intended to be exhaustive in any field and will have served its purpose if it introduces such people to their fields of study and provides students elsewhere in Australia with an indication of the nature and present extent of the collections in this State.

The chief, and at the present unavoidable omission in this survey, is a detailed list of the documents still held by the various State and Commonwealth departments in Western Australia, and by local government bodies. Most of these records have not yet been surveyed. Although this will be commenced in the near future, the transfer of these records to the Archives will not take place for some considerable time owing to lack of space and staff, and during that period they will be available for research only after permission has been obtained from the head of the department concerned.

In addition to the documents and publications listed in the following pages, the Archives has an extensive collection of maps, photographs and relics, and the Historical Society of Western Australia has a large number of pamphlets and newspaper cuttings. References to diaries and other private papers which are not immediately accessible will be found in the bibliographies of the unpublished theses mentioned in Section IV.

The compilation of this guide was made possible by the willing assistance of the Archivist, Miss M. F. F. Lukis, and by the very helpful co-operation of the staff of the Public Library.
