


Copy of Smart Tickets 563 A/9C

 These are to certify the Directors of the Chest at Greenwich that Mr. John Septimus Roe, (quantity) Master that was, wounded on board His Majesty's Sloop Bathurst by receiving a severe contused and lacerated wound of the scalp of the right side of his forehead, occasioned by a fall from the foretopmast head to the forecastle of the said Sloop on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June 1821, being then actually upon His Majesty's Service in keeping a lookout ahead while the said Sloop was employed on a Survey of the Coast of New Holland - Aged about 25 years and 9 months Born after near London

In the County of Middlesex  
Dark Hair - Blue eyes - Fallow complexion - Stature  
5 feet 9 inches - Particular marks or scars, a  
triangular shaped wound over right eye, a scar  
on his left heel, and one on his right leg in front,  
below the calf.

Dated the 24<sup>th</sup> day of January 1823.
