

Explorations in W. A. by I. Roe. True for!

- 3 Nov. 1831 - ^{traversed the Albany} Country about Southful hl. Bay - Torbay, Wilsons inlet -
- 4 ~~Nov~~ - Kalgardion, Kojonup, &c. &c.
- 2 Jan. 1830 - Explores the country about Recherchelet, River Colthe, ^{Ferguson &} Preston, Cape Naturalist & Geographic Bay, -
- 6 ~~Jan~~ 1835. To Pujarra on Murray R., Bumbury, Kojonup, Albany & Perth.
- 8 Sept. 1835. Explores country by two different routes between Perth & Albany - for a main arterial road -
- 9 Oct. Nov. 1836. Explores the country 180 miles east and 100 miles north from Perth -
- 7 1835. Examined the unknown country around Moorville ~~of~~ on Kalgarion River, & the Rivers Hay, Peeman, Blackwood, &c.
- 1 1 Mar 1829 - Arrived at Swan River with the 1st for. Capt. Stirling ^{R.M.} & commenced immediately to survey the harbour, ^{approach, adjacent} anchorage & coast & country - Explored the Swan & Canning Rivers, & fixed on ~~the mouth~~ ^{site for permanent} the mouth of the Swan as the Port Town, and ^{on Perth} as the capital & head quarters - Men - one richly employed as ^{the total of} staff -
- 5 1832. Examined country about Rivers Arthur & William, & located settlers -
- 10 Dec. 1837 - Discover & survey Pul Hael. & Warbro's Pond
- 11 Jan. 1838. Closely examined coast between Swan River & Cape Naturalist
- 12 Nov. 1838. Explored country between Swan River & Bumbury, via Rivers Murray, Hawey, Colthe & Preston, back by base of ^{Coey and} Darling Range -
- 13 May 1839. Passed over new line of country, to 70 miles north from Perth, and rescued from impending death ^{by starvation} 3 men remaining from W. Grey's exploring party -
- 14 Dec. 1839. Overland with Gen. Sturt, to Albany & back by different routes not before traversed
- 15 June 1847. Explored the country around, & 40 miles north of, Champion Bay
- 16 Sept 48 to Feb. 49 (5 months) explored the country from Avon River to Stirling Range, & thence eastward to Rapall Range & Cape Parley, ^{on the south coast} & 50 to 100 miles inland, returning by different route - On this occasion discovered coal on the Rivers Fitzgerald & Phillips - Personally injured, & incapacitated for further exploring - This a very trying expedition -
- 17 Various ^{other} smaller examinations of ~~new~~ country, too numerous to be particularized -
