

Explorations in W. A. by Sloe. Part One.

Traversed the Albany.

- 3 Nov. 1831 - Country about Doubtful H^d. Bay - Torbay, Wilcox's Let -
4 Do - Kalgoorlie, Kojonup, &c. &c. Ferguson &
2 Jan. 1830 - Explored the country about Leschenaultt, River Cottle, & Preston, Cape
Naturalist & Geographie Bay, -
6 Sept. 1833. To Pajama on Murray R., Bumby, Kojonup, Albany & Perth.
8 Sept. 1835. Explored country by two different routes between Perth & Albany - for
a main arterial road -
9 Oct. Nov. 1836. Explored the country 180 miles east and 100 miles north
from Perth.
7 1835. Examined the unknown country around Morrilup & on Kalgan
River, & the Rivers Hay, Steeman, Blackwood, &c.
1 Dec. 1829. Arrived at Swan River with the 1st fort, Capt. Stirling &^{R.R.}
commenced immediately to survey the harbor, ^{approaches, adjacent} anchorages & coast
country. Explored the Swan & Canning Rivers, & fixed on ^{site for temporary} ~~Swan~~
~~mouth of the Swan as the Fort Town, and on Perth as the~~
capital headquarters ^{the total of} ~~as~~ Melbourne. One widely surveyor as ^{to} ~~as~~ ^{part} of
staff -
5. 1832. Examined country about River of William & William, & located settlers.
10 Dec. 1837. Discovered & surveyed Peel Harbor & Warabro' Pound.
11 Jan. 1838. Closely examined coast between Swan River & Cap Naturaliste.
12 June 1838. Explored country between Swan River & Bumby, via River Murray, Harvey,
Cottle & Preston, back by base of ^{Loc. and} Darling Range.
13 May 1839. Passed over new line of country, to 70 miles north from Perth, and rescued
from impending death ^{starvation} 13 men remaining from Mr. Grey's exploring party.
14 Dec. 1839. Overland with Gen. Hutt, to Albany back by different route not
before traversed.
15 June 1847. Explored the country around, & 40 miles north of Champion Bay.
16 Sept. 48 to Feb. 49 (5 months) explored the country from Arounbar to Parley Bay,
& thence eastward to Capell Range & Cape Parley, & 60 to 100 miles inland,
returning by different route. On this occasion discovered coal on the Rins
Fitzgerald & Phillips. Personally injured, & incapacitated for
further exploring. This a very trying expedition.
17 Various, ^{other} smaller examinations of ~~new~~ country, too numerous to be
