hath taken Apprentice *John Septimus Roe*
one of the Boys of his late Majesty King *Charles* the Second's
Royal Foundation in *Christ's Hospital, London*, for Seven Years,
from this Day, **Now know We** that the said *Sir Christopher*
Cole doth hereby covenant and agree to and with
the Governors of the said Hospital, that he will not at any Time
or Times hereafter, during the said Term, dispose of or turn
over the said *John Septimus Roe*
to any Person or Persons whomsoever, without the Leave and
Consent of the said Governors, for the Time being, first had
and obtained. **And also** that the said *John Septimus*
Roe shall, at some convenient Time after the
Space of the three first Years of his Apprenticeship, bring and
produce his Journal of such Voyages as he shall have made, to-
gether with his Log-Book, to a Committee of the Governors of
the said Hospital. **And** the said *Sir Christopher*
Cole doth also agree to allow the Sum of
Nine pounds & Eight Shillings for such Charges
as the Hospital shall be at for Books, Instruments, and other ex-
traordinary Disbursements, out of the second Payment, pursuant
to an Order of Court of the Governors of the said Hospital.
