Notes for James C BATES

Convict - arrived 21 Oct 1819 on "Grenada 1". Convicted at Middlesex in 1818 for 7 years, 23 (20) yo, a labourer by profession. Convicted in London in 1818 of stealing 28 yards of cotton valued at 1 pound 10 shillings from a Thomas Garner.

From 1821 resided in Parramatta and early Dec granted permission to marry Elizabeth Alcock; he was attached to the Government lumberyard. By early 1824, assigned as a convict mechanic. From this period he was described as a nail maker residing in Parramatta.

James bought 120 acres land in Prospect from Lewis Henry Campbell in September 1827. In the 1828 census he was listed having 120 acres comprising 60 acres of cleared land and 10 acres under cultivation; he had 3 horses and 16 head horned cattle.

House built in Prospect about 1830. Still exists in Prospect (37 Roger Place, Seven Hills) owned by Jeff and Josette Woolley. Visited in March 2006 - they bought and renovated the house in 1993 after being left vacant for many years.
