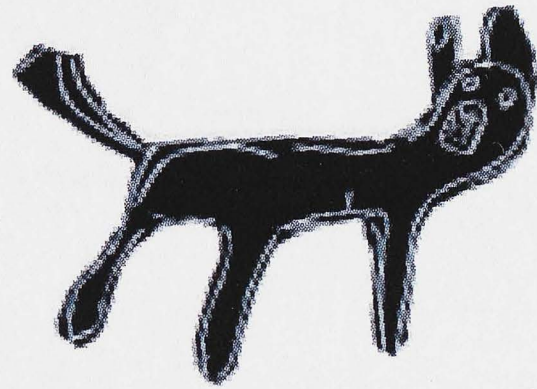

creek near Beaton Bore.

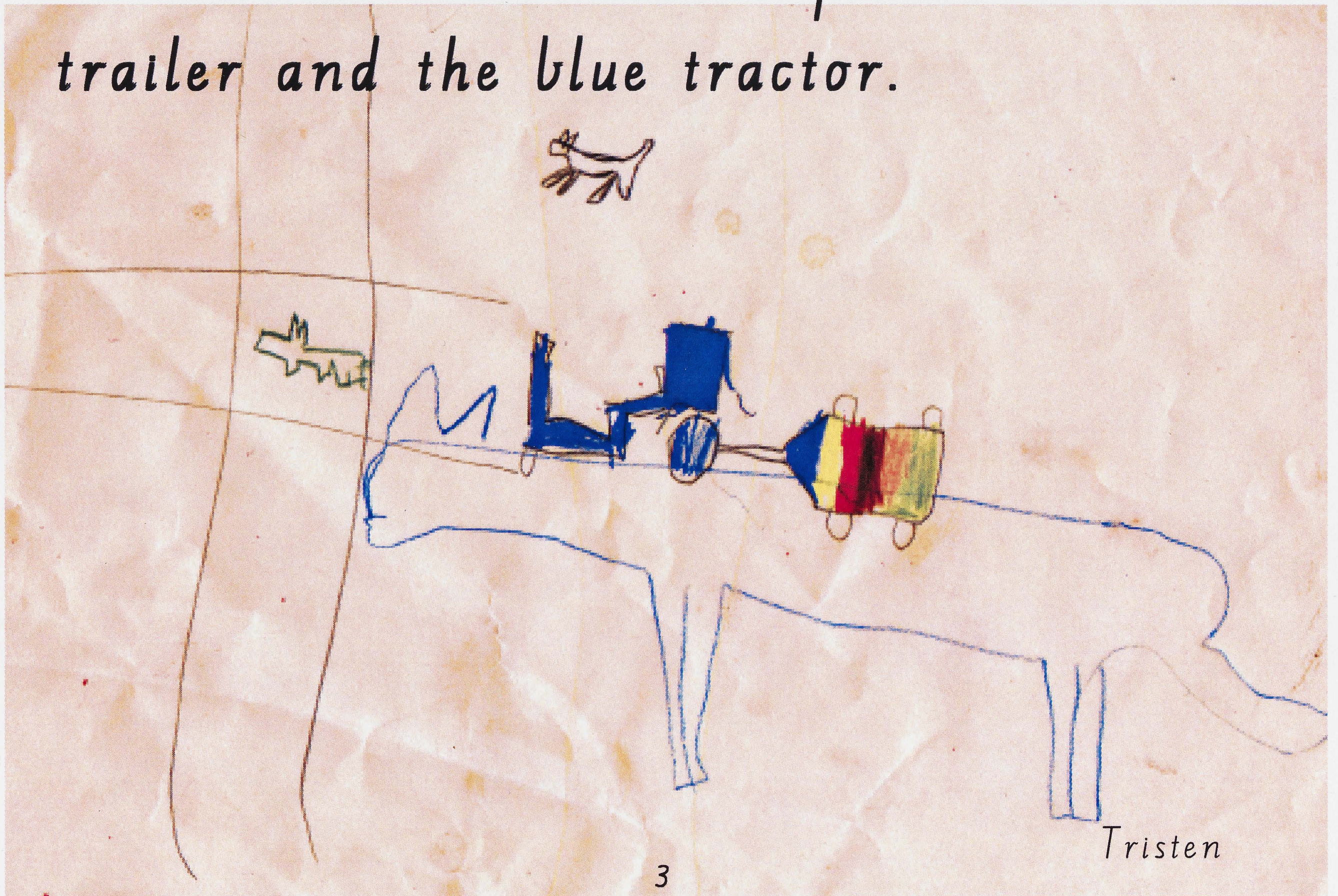

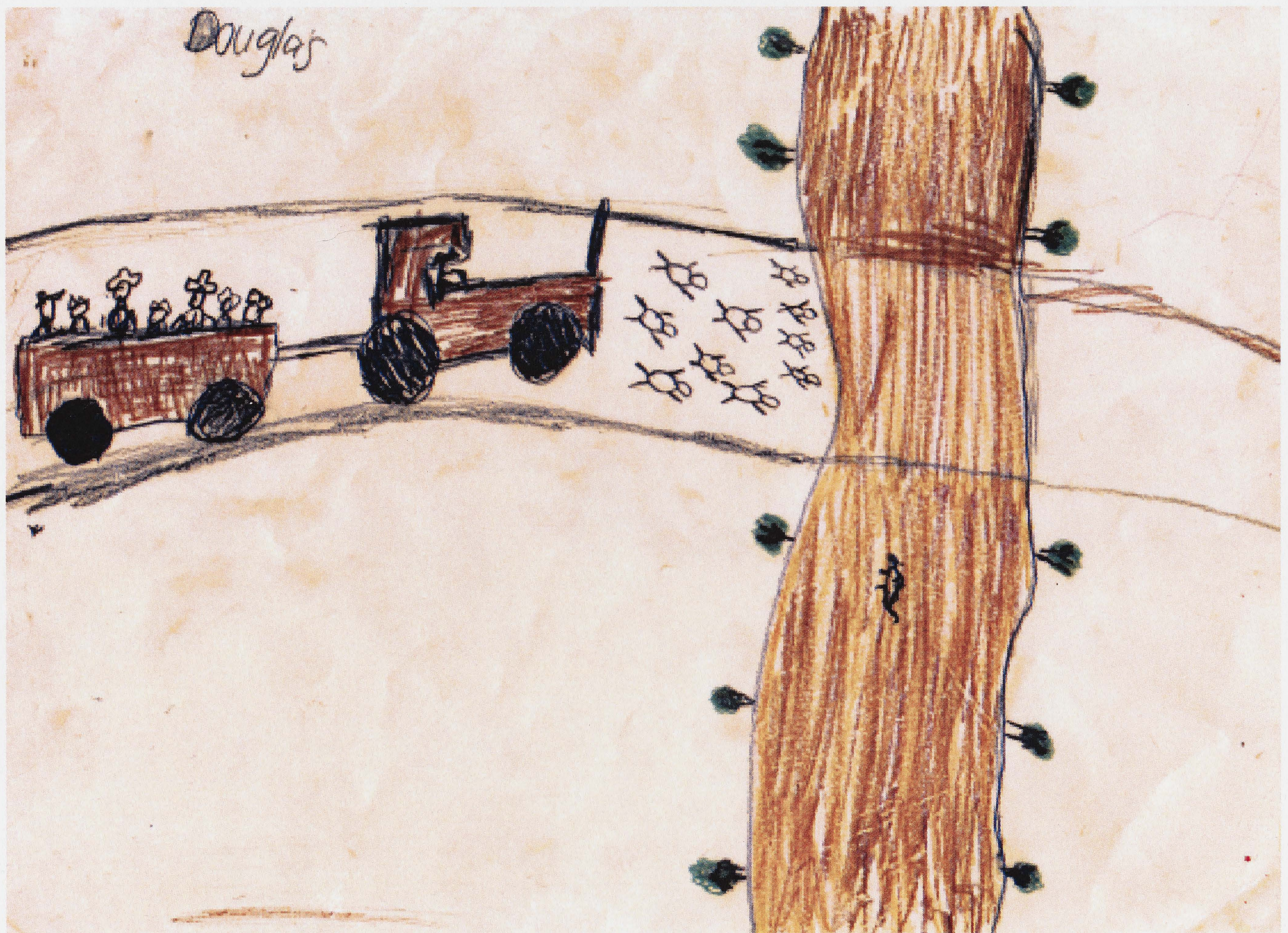


While we were hunting, we had 'big rain'. We had a big storm! We had so much rain that the creek came up.

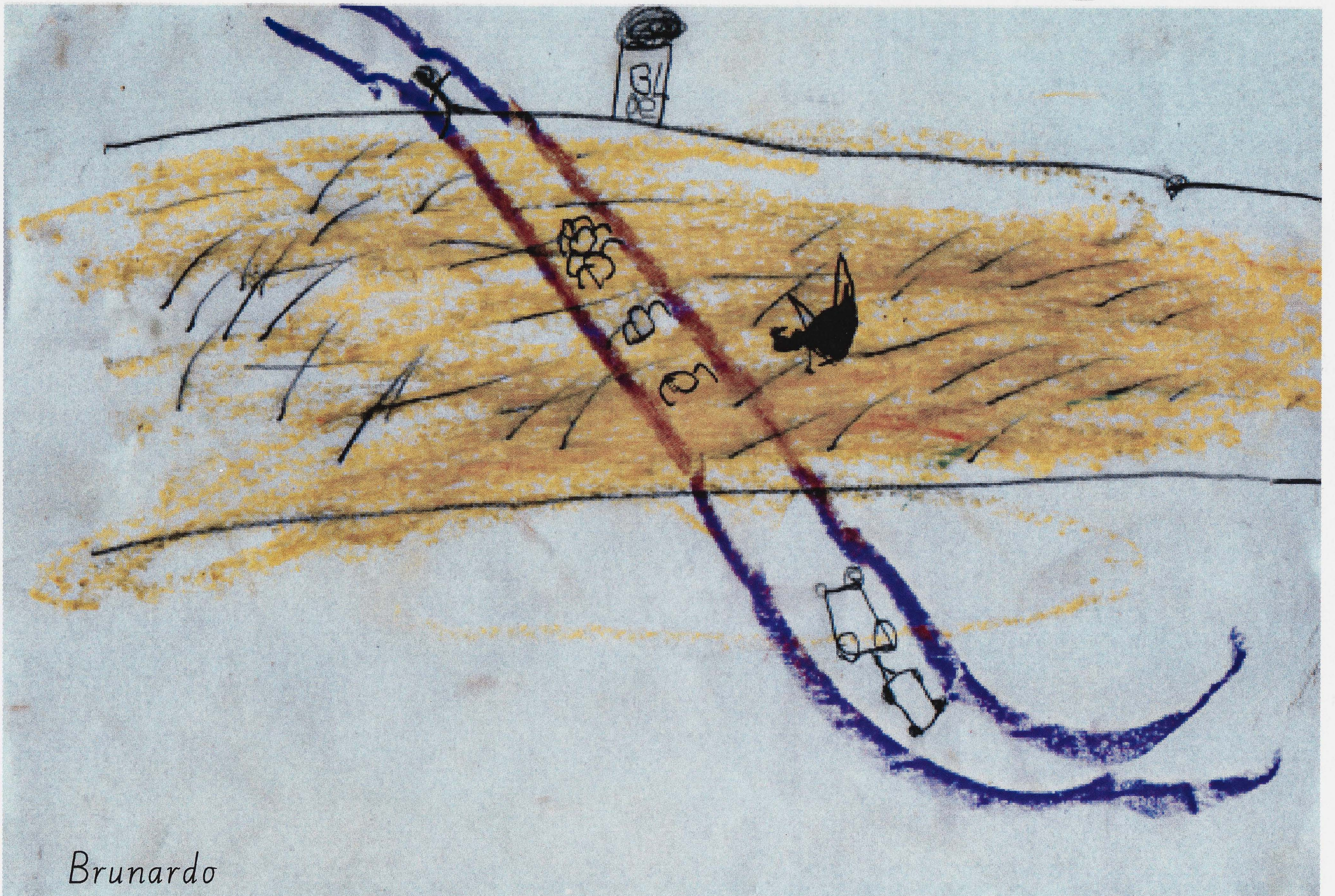

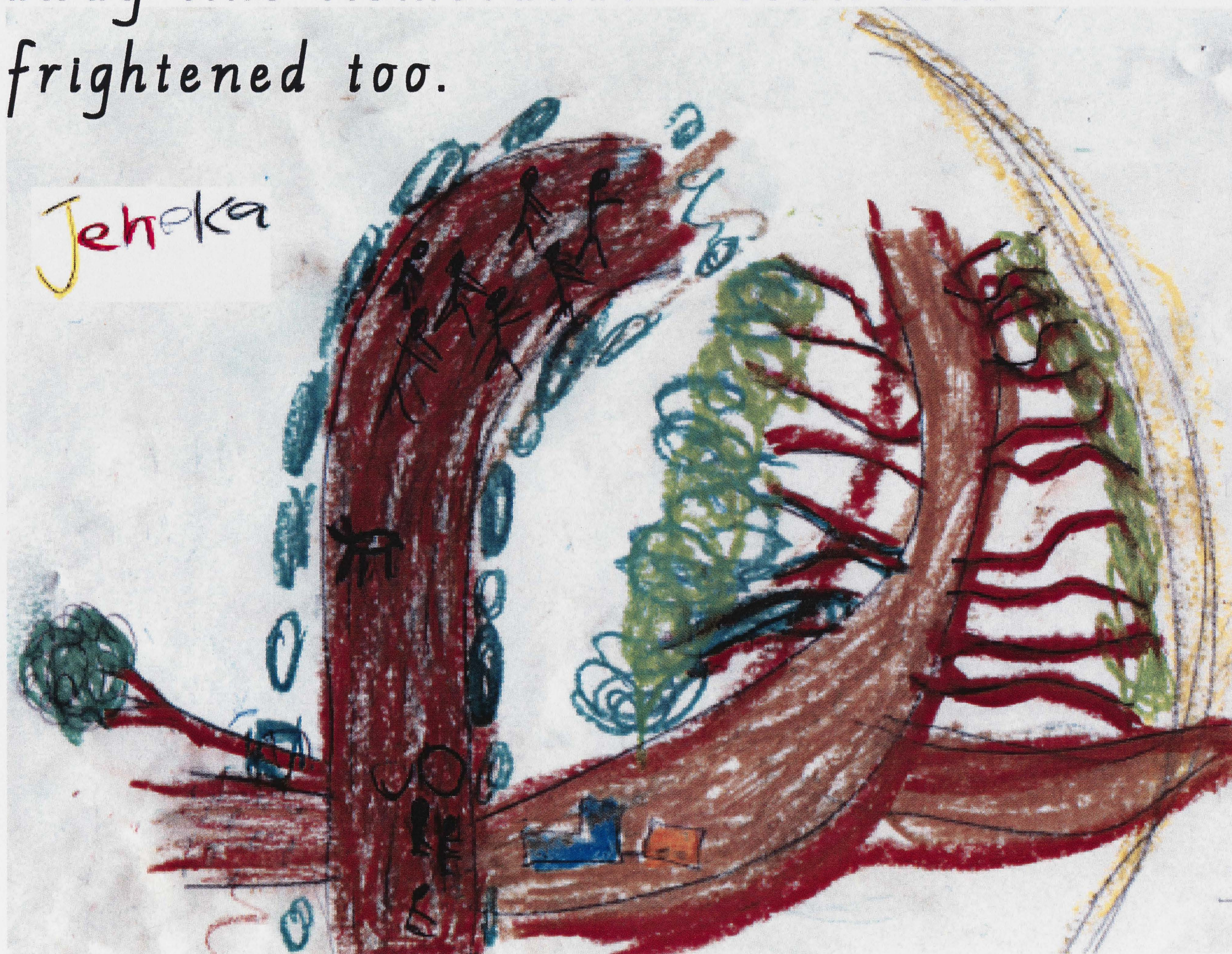
When we got back to the creek ... The creek was running very fast. The water was very deep.

he made it across with Ricky.

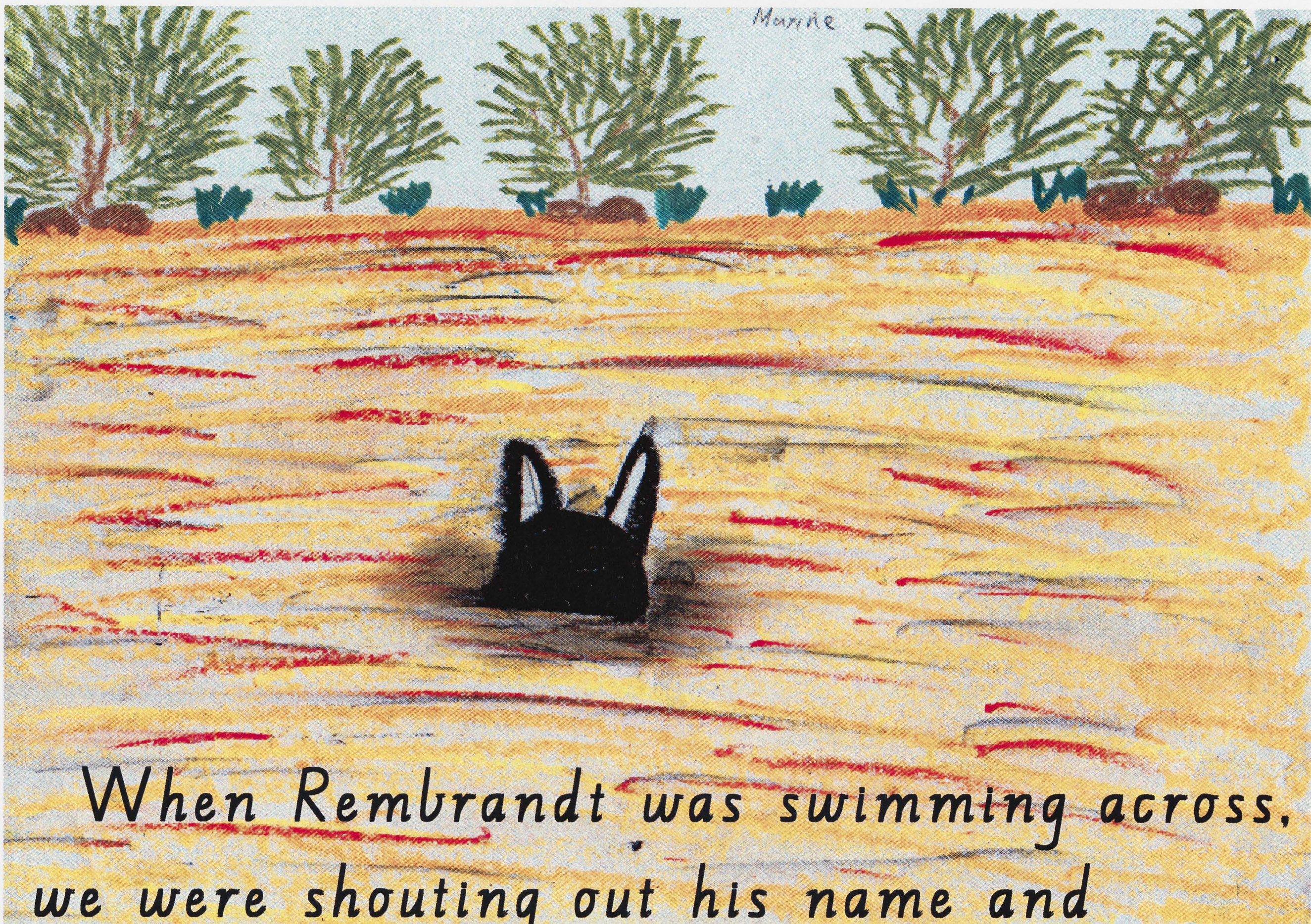
