All are invited to Dawn Butterworth's home for the meeting and light supper afterwards. SA reported that they are concerned about the lack of succession in the SA Chapter and the aging membership. This applies not just to SA but to all Chapters nationally and the national Secretariat. At the Board meeting it was moved that the Constitution and By Laws be looked at in order to change the present requirement of Chapters needing to have at least 20 financial members to have a Director. It was suggested that it be changed to a membership of 10 financial members. The Constitution states that there are to be a minimum of 3 Directors and a
