

BUSINESS ARISING FROM MINUTES: ANNUAL SUBS: Proposed Jim Williams that fees remain same as last year. Chris Quinn suggested a rise in fees to prevent Club capital being depleted and to cover cost of postage increase (if any). After discussion the majority agreed to leave the SUBS as they stand: \$15.00 Metro and \$10.00 Country. The motion was seconded by B. Bennie. To be reviewed at next Annual General Meeting.


