

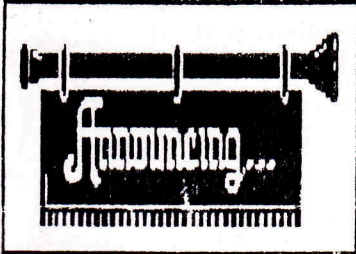

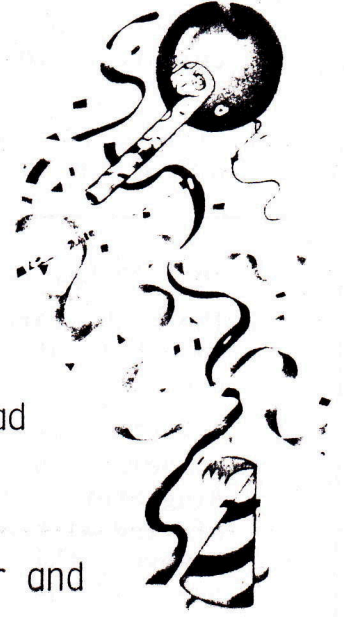

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING  
held at Noranda School, Walmsley Drive, Noranda, on  
SUNDAY, JULY 25, 1993.

MINUTES OF 1992 AGM were read and accepted. Moved: D. Heard seconded N. Williams.

BUSINESS ARISING FROM MINUTES: ANNUAL SUBS: Proposed Jim Williams that fees remain same as last year. Chris Quinn suggested a rise in fees to prevent Club capital being depleted and to cover cost of postage increase (if any).
