JUDGING STANDARDS ORGANISER: Bill Bennie has taken on this position and will keep members advised.



November 4th - All Ford Day (arranged by Falcon GT Club and Mustang Owners Club). This event will be discussed at our coming meeting.


November 25th - Run to Harvey. This is to be a one day event with a starting time of 9:00 am. Further information next newsletter.
