GEARS:

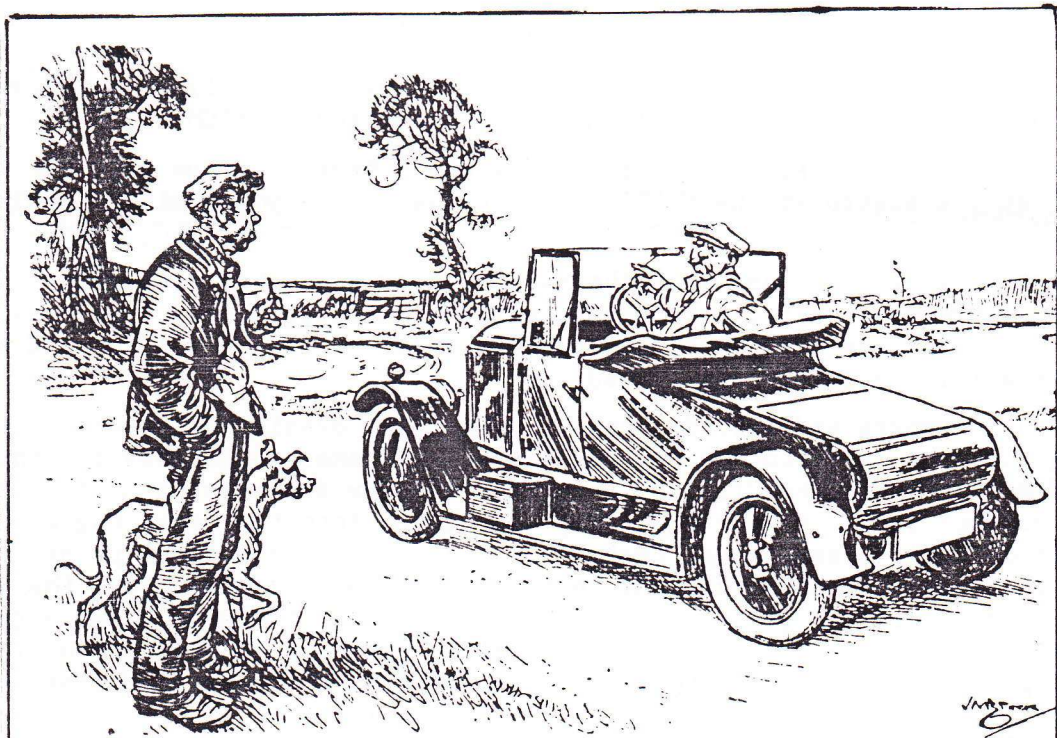
